



SEMMA

Semma is a Michelin-star restaurant in the West Village from the Unapologetic Indian team. Focused on Southern Indian cuisine, many of their dishes have never been seen outside of India, until now. To pay homage to the Chef's authenticity, we sought to create an environment equally transportive. Inspiration came from the houseboats of Kerala & the iconic Kathakali dancers. When designing the furniture, we turned to Pierre Jeanneret's mid-century chairs—providing a conceptual template for the built-in banquettes with internally illuminated cane backs. As soon as you step into Semma you have stepped out of the West Village and feel like you are taking a journey down the Kaveri River.

PEACHY KEEN

This '70s-inspired restaurant with a modern twist features high-quality eats, over-the-top sweets, and nostalgic cocktails. The goal for the project was to create an energetic yet comfortable space that captures the spirit of the city with a vibrant atmosphere that still feels familiar. Bold colors & materials were used to create diverse and playful dining and drinking areas. The restaurant embodies both fun and fair, a rare combination in most fast casual dining spaces today.

BABY BRASA

Our client, a renowned Celebrity chef & Master Chef judge, asked Wid Chapman Architects to upgrade his wildly popular West Village Restaurant. The design brief was to represent his Peruvian, European origins in the design to complement his original cuisine. Walls are clad in custom walnut slatted wood and murals of tropical plant leaves. The ceiling panels are wrapped in linen, with rattan light fixtures & wood fans. Tropical plants are integrated into the design throughout.



INDUSTRY KITCHEN

Industry Kitchen is an indoor and outdoor restaurant and bar located under Manhattan's FDR Drive, just south of South Street Seaport. Nestled under the overpass, it is housed in an iconic structure designed by SHoP Architects, just yards from the East River's edge. The inspiration for the design of the restaurant evolved organically from the awe-inspiring site & view, which called for an industrial raw, and authentic approach, its color palette is clean & simple to complement the building's cutting-edges design.

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WATERMARK BAR

Watermark Bar is a stunning 3,500 square-foot venue with indoor and outdoor space, perched on the edge of the double-level Pier 15 adjacent to New York's historic South Street Seaport. Steel and glass make up the structure of the venue, and floor-to-ceiling windows seamlessly separate the indoor and outdoor areas, framing a picturesque view of the waterfront that can be enjoyed all year.








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TAMARIND TRIBECA

Tamarind Tribeca is the second Tamarind completed by the firm. The challenge was to make the most of its soaring loft space while creating warm, intimate pockets for dining and drinking. The design for the restaurant epitomizes the firm's sensibility for conceiving restaurant spaces as a series of vibrant "urban" social places.

70 PINE STREET

This landmarked 1930s art deco skyscraper (previously the AIG building) is a key player in the revitalization of New York City's Financial District. The design for this bi-level 14,000 square feet fine dining establishment celebrates the building's historical significance and unique architectural features. Modern interpretation and honest use of materiality create a luxurious, comfortable and timeless atmosphere.







245 PARK AVENUE

Located in the heart of a major corporate office district, this vast, light-filled space, with floor-to-ceiling windows and 20' ceilings, was filled with tremendous potential. We were charged with creating a high-end restaurant, showcasing modern American cuisine, both luxurious and accessible. The restaurant features a large bar anchoring the major wall of windows. The back bar, with large, see-through arches, screens the bar area from the main dining. Various-sized private dining rooms and modern "snug" lounges in the rear call to mind an exclusive, members-only club.






BEEKMAN TOWER

Beekman Tower, a New York City Landmark 1928 art deco skyscraper in Midtown Manhattan, was designed by renowned architect John Mead Howells. The firm was commissioned to transform its top floor cocktail lounge and bar, famous for its sweeping views of the city.

LE CAFÉ COFFEE

In 2010, our firm was commissioned to create branding for a French start-up, Le Café, & we have designed ten stores in NYC to date. Each iteration presented a fresh opportunity to evaluate the brand's evolving identity and to incorporate refinements. The latest location, on Eighth Avenue just off Columbus Circle, is the most high-profile venue to date, reflecting the most extensive update to the brand environment. Walls are capped with a sweeping curve, ending at an integrated cubby display band around the space, and a separate compact French retail area completes the design.

H&H BAGELS

"Like no other bagel in the world," H&H Bagels has been an iconic destination on New York City's Upper West Side for fifty years. In 2021, our firm was hired to lead the brand into its next iteration, upgrading the original store's visual environment, brand identity, & customer experience, and translating this for an upscale store in the new Moynihan Train Hall. It was one of the first shops to open in this vital urban space. These projects led to a wider partnership with H&H Bagels as it seeks to expand exponentially, and we are working on a comprehensive franchise design model for the company.

ROWDY ROOSTER

Rowdy Rooster is one of the most distinctive chicken shacks on the East Coast, serving authentic spicy and crispy Indian-style fried chicken—another hit from the Unapologetic Indian team. This is our fifth restaurant for them (Dhamaka, Semma, Masalawla and Son). Our design had to reflect the idea of a restaurant that just popped up in the street overnight. The feelings we sought to capture were: ramshackle, colorful and fun. We used wooden painted crates to cover the walls and incorporated the rooster motif through mural art in a playful and eclectic manner.


